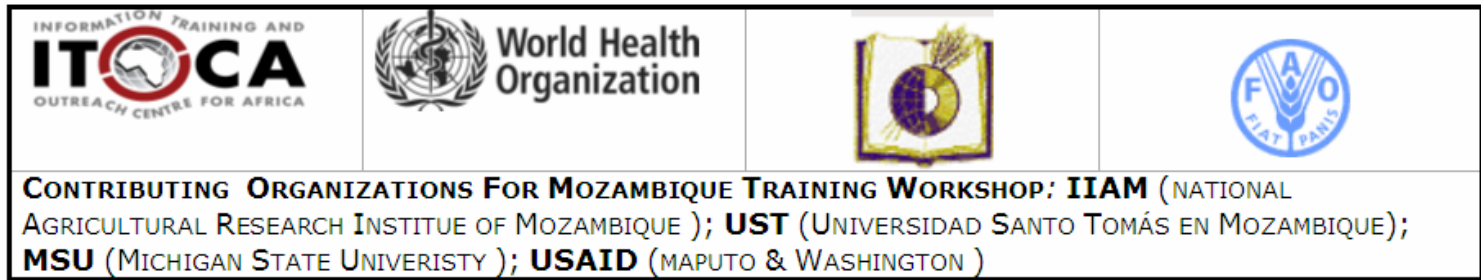

Globalizar a língua portuguesa

Por outro lado, especialistas das áreas de documentação, pesquisadores, médicos, veterinários, agrónomos e educadores dos ministérios da saúde e da agricultura de alguns dos países da CPLP estão, estiveram reunidos em Maputo numa formação de formadores de Acesso Electrónico Global em Agricultura (AGORA) e Acesso à Rede Electrónica de Saúde (HINARI).

Entretanto, Gracian Chipwaza, coordenador do projecto de formação de formadores explicou que, um dos principais obstáculos na edificação da capacidade institucional e desenvolvimento em África foi sempre a falta de acesso à informação científica. Neste contexto, a contribuição das comunidades científicas e das bibliotecas era limitada. Daí que, para fazer face a essas dificuldades, o português já tem uma vasta comunidade falante no mundo, razão pela qual justifico-me o esforço no sentido de o globalizar, ou seja, fazer com que ele seja, à semelhança do inglês e do francês, uma das línguas da globalização. Cerca de 220 milhões de pessoas falam português em todo o mundo, o que faz com que esta língua seja a sexta mais falada do mundo. A presença política de Portugal na Ásia fez-lhe-ligar-se a Macau, mas os portugueses já controlaram regiões mais extensas, que incluem partes da Índia, da Indonésia, do Sri Lanka e da Malásia.

Entre os séculos XVI e XVIII, o português serve de língua franca nos portos da Índia e sudeste da Ásia, estabelecendo a comunicação entre povos de línguas diferentes. Entretanto, o único lugar onde o Português sobrevive na sua forma oficial é Goa, na Índia, onde está sendo gradualmente substituído pelo Inglês.

Em Damão e Diu (Índia), Java (Indonésia), Macau (possessão portuguesa, de população predominantemente chinesa), Sri Lanka e em Maláca (Malásia) são faladas variedades de crioulo ilíacas que derivam de grande desenvolvimento sanitário e de luta contra doenças prioritárias nos países lusófonos.

Na verdade, trata-se de um curso sobre como usar meios electrónicos de informação para a pesquisa de dados e outros trabalhos científicos sobre saúde e agricultura.

Como o curso é direccionado aos formadores, temos que consequentemente, eles aprenderão a ensinar informações através de meios electrónicos para a melhoria do seu trabalho.

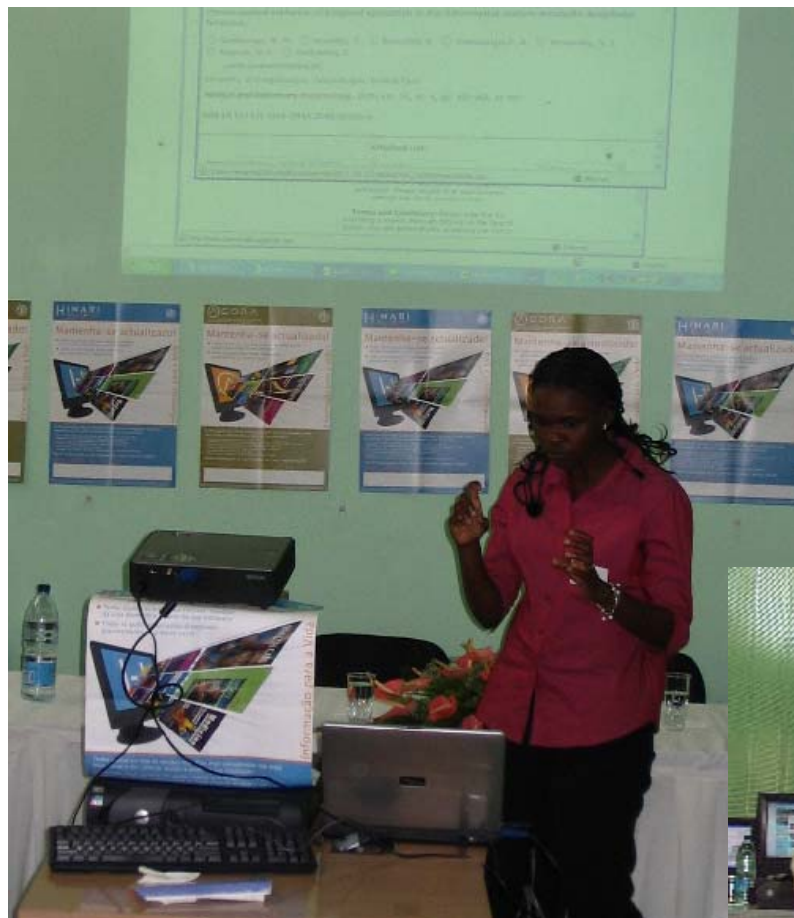
Um pesquisador na área de agricultura, por exemplo, pode ter acesso a informações sobre como tratar melhor as suas sementes e a partir daí poderá disseminar essa informação para o resto dos intervenientes na área.

Na área de saúde, o impacto será o mesmo. Os especialistas poderão encontrar artigos relacionados com os seus trabalhos diários, o que contribuirá para a melhoria da sua prestação.

Pensa-se que esta informação poderá ser importante para a melhoria na área de saúde, na agricultura para os pesquisadores. É que, tendo acesso ao que foi até aqui ser publicado noutros países, eles obtêm informações sobre várias doenças já desenvolvidas em outros países e assim não vão poder gastar mais fundos para a investigação.

De resto, a ideia visa trazer o mundo globalizado para o benefício de todos. Em Outubro passado, a OMS promoveu, em Maputo, um curso de formação de editores médicos. No âmbito, o que se pretendia era que os editores das revistas especializadas em matéria de saúde se institucionalizassem e buscassem tratar a informação inovacionista.

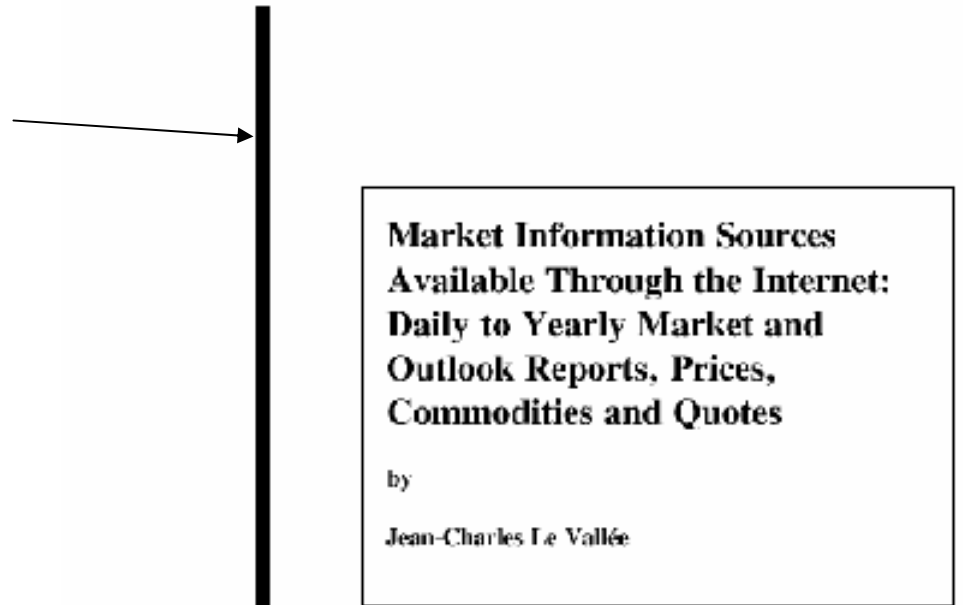

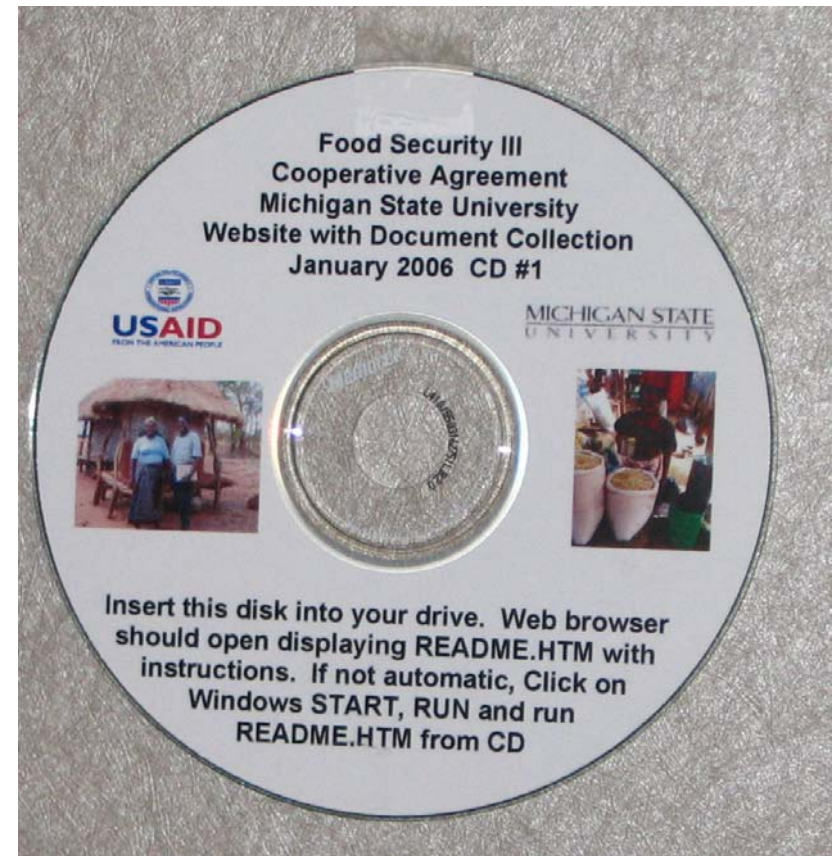

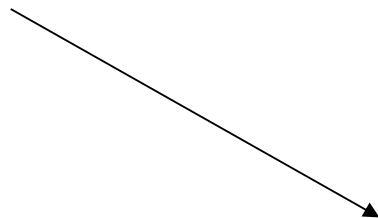
